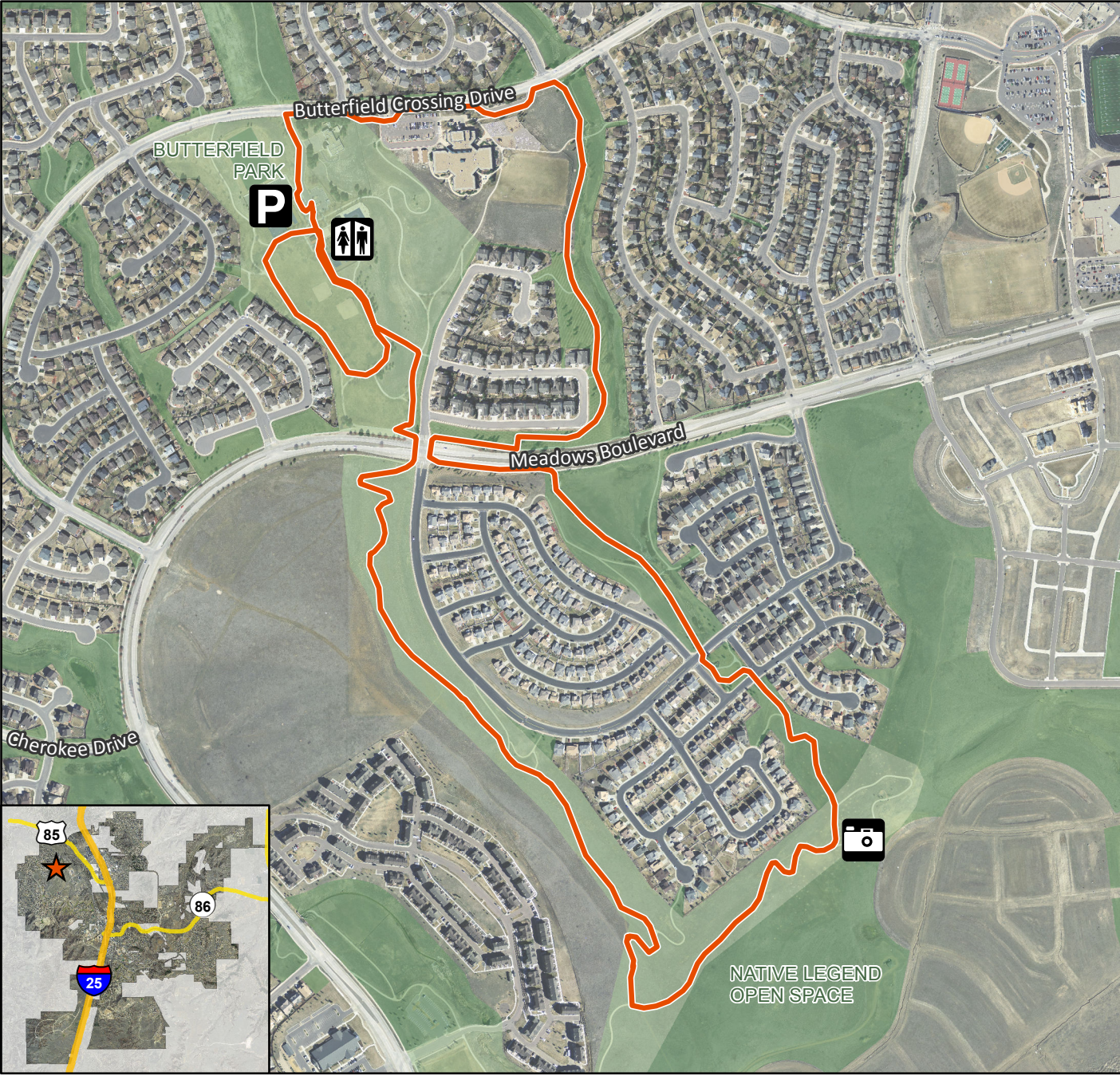
Connecting several segments of the Native Legend Trail, this 8-foot wide paved loop is perfect for running, biking or an evening stroll. The 3.2 mile route has views of the Castle Rock valley. The educational signs along the way give information about the area's geological history.

The Meadows 5k loop is in the heart of The Meadows neighborhood and easily accessible. The gently sloping trail goes through Butterfield Park and paved paths in the open space around it. Follow the loop at Butterfield Park to get the full 5K length. There are benches to rest along the route. Use caution when crossing the road.

A family-friendly trail.
